## **Raw material and innovation: Glazed Basalto from Umbria**

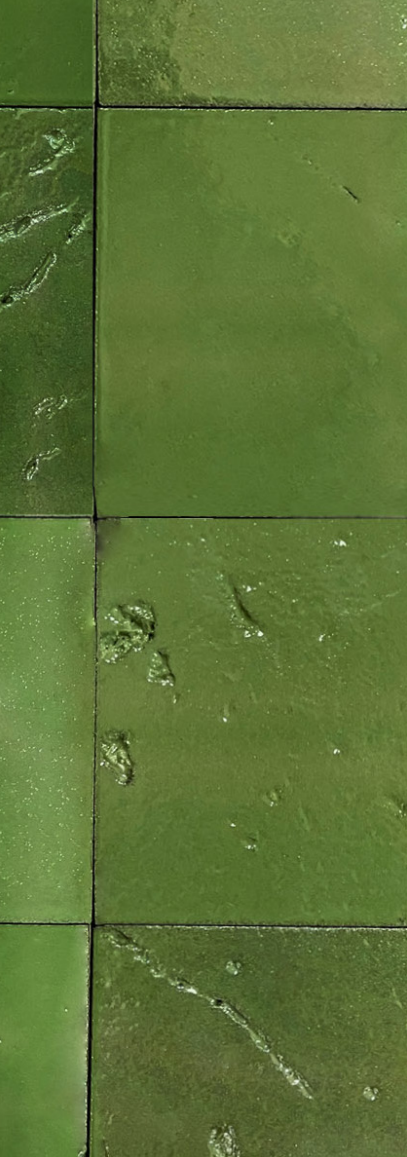
The passion for natural stone comes from over 60 years of experience and has guided every choice and inspiration of the Materika team.

Thanks to its physical and mechanical characteristics, it has not only withstood the test of time but has also been used for mosaics, prestigious glazed tiles, and decorations, including the use of lustre techniques during the Renaissance.

This stone, along with the study of new glazes, allows for the creation of unique products in terms of shape and colors.







## The meaning of "Materika"

Materika was founded by young entrepreneurs from Umbria with a strong tradition in stone works for residential and nautical applications, along with glazing masters who uses the oldest artisan fusion techniques.

The name "Materika" comes from the Latin "mater," which in this context refers to Mother Earth and material.

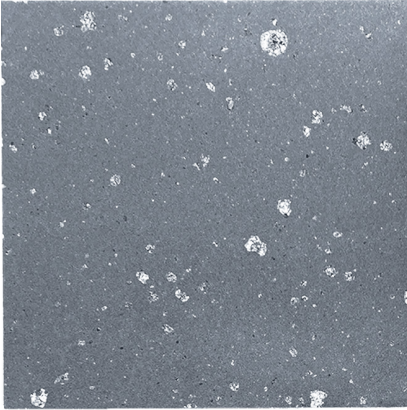
"I" stands for Italy and technological innovation, which makes this product unique in terms of resistance, ductility of use, and beauty.

"K" represents potassium, the element that characterizes the rock and interacts in the chemical transformation process.

"A" stands for art and craftsmanship, the recovery of techniques, and the tradition that accompanies the development of various cultures.



## Natural Collection



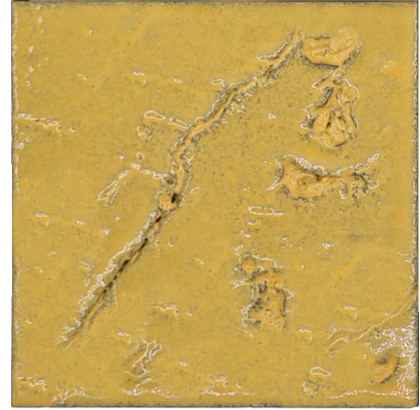

## Classic Collection



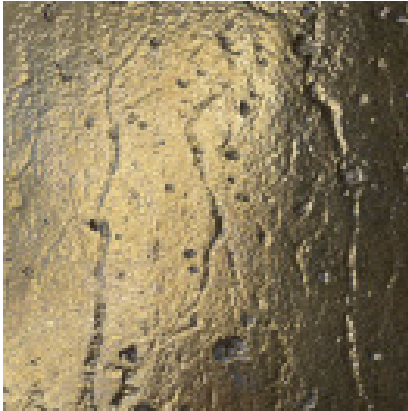
The Classic Collection highlights the natural characteristics of Basalto while maintaining the presence of crystals, an unrepeatable feature of this stone.

The Matt Collection offers soft and neutral colors that are not glossy, allowing for warmer and more natural colors.

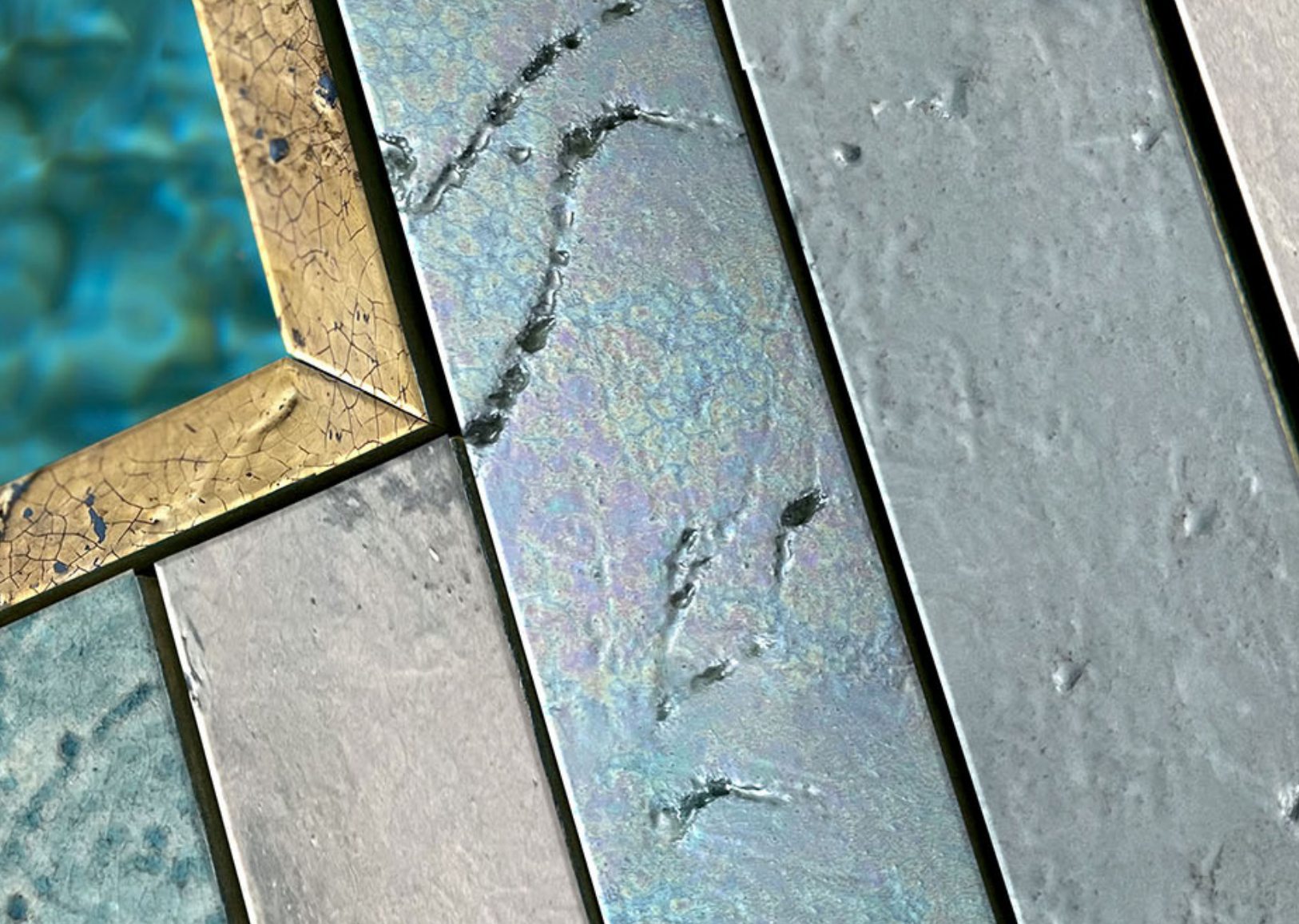

## Formats, mosaics and compositions

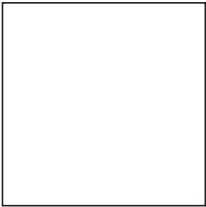
